This letter is a follow up to the review and subsequent telephone call to your office concerning deficiencies which exist with your application for transfer. These deficiencies need to be cured in order for us to process your application.

Deficiencies

- 1. List of utility assets not transferred. Pursuant to Rule 25-30.037(4)(d), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), a list is to be included with the transfer application of any utility assets not transferred to the governmental authority if such remaining assets constitute a system providing water or wastewater service to the public for compensation. Since the transfer application indicates that a portion of the utility's systems are being transferred to the City of Sebring, there appears to be remaining utility assets as defined above. Please provide the list of utility assets not transferred.
- 2. Map showing remaining territory. Pursuant to Rule 25-30.037(5)(b), F.A.C., a copy of the official county tax assessment map, or other map, showing township, range, and section with a scale such as 1"=200' or 1"=400', with the remaining territory plotted thereon by use of metes and bounds or quarter sections, and with a defined reference point of beginning is to be provided. No such map was received with the application. Please provide the necessary map.
