RESOLUTION No. 01-035

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA'S OBJECTION TO THE SITING OF A POWER PLANT ON THE EASTERN BORDER OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

1 WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek has received applications to site a power
2 plant adjacent to the eastern border of Coconut Creek, and

3 WHEREAS, the emissions from the power plant will negatively impact the air
4 quality of the City of Coconut Creek because the plant would be partially fueled by diesel,
5 and

6 WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek has determined that the prevailing
7 southeastern wind would put the citizens of the City in the direct path of these dangerous
8 emissions and thereby create a public nuisance that diminishes the quality of life and
9 negatively impacts property values within the City of Coconut Creek, and

10 WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek is already suffering the severely negative
11 consequences of the adjacent Central Sanitary Landfill, the Broward County Wastewater
12 Treatment Plant, Broward County Trash Transfer Station and the Broward County Mass
13 Transit Depot, all of which have a detrimental impact upon the air quality in the residential
14 areas of the City of Coconut Creek,

15 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
16 CITY OF LAUDERDALE LAKES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2. EXPRESSION OF SUPPORT AND ENCOURAGEMENT: The City Commission hereby expresses support to the City of Coconut Creek in its efforts to prevent the siting of a power plant on its eastern border.

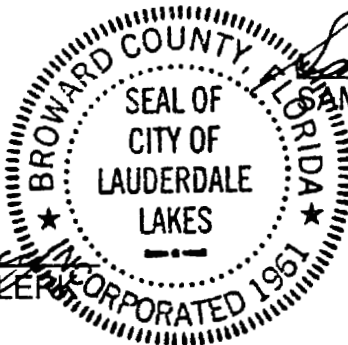
Section 3. INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CITY CLERK: The City Clerk is hereby instructed to distribute certified copies of this Resolution to the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek, and other public agencies involved with the permitting and construction of the proposed power plant.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.
