On September 5, 2000, Docket No. 001313-TI was established to address TJ134's failure to remit RAFs for the years 1999 and 2000. By Order No. PSC-01-1009-PAA-TI, issued on April 24, 2001, the Commission approved the cancellation of TJ134's Interexchange Telecommunications Certificate No. 5696 due to bankruptcy. The Commission further ordered that the outstanding Regulatory Assessment Fees not be sent to the Comptroller's Office for collection, but instead, that the Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services should request permission to write-off the uncollectible amount.

Therefore, staff requests that Bureau of Administrative Services/Fiscal Services Section take the appropriate steps to seek permission from the Comptroller's Office to write-off the uncollectible RAFs for the years 1999 and 2000 for TJ134.
