FLORIDA WATER SERVICES CORPORATION'S MOTION FOR WAIVER OF NOTICING REQUIREMENTS IN THE ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE

Florida Water Services Corporation ("Florida Water"), by and through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Rule 28-106.204(1), Florida Administrative Code, hereby moves for a waiver of the noticing requirements set forth in the <u>Order Establishing Procedure</u>, Order No. PSC-00-1170-WS issued June 27, 2000 in the above-referenced docket. In support of this Motion, Florida Water states as follows:

1. On June 27, 2000, the Prehearing Order issued the <u>Order Establishing Procedure</u> in this docket. Under the section of the Order entitled <u>Notice and Public Information</u>, at page 3, the Order states:

The Utility shall comply with the requirements of Rule 25-22.0405, *Florida Administrative Code*. The Utility shall publish notice of the date, time, location, and purpose of the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected. The date of publication shall be no less than 14 and no more than 30 days prior to the first day of the hearing.

Moreover, pursuant to Rule 25-22.0405, *Florida Administrative Code*, the Utility shall give written notice of the date, time, location, and purpose of the hearing to each of the customers in the area affected no less than 14 days prior to the first day of the hearing. The Utility shall utilize first class mail for notices sent to customers with out of town mailing addresses.

In addition, the above-described notices shall also include a statement that any customer comments regarding the Utility's service

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or the proposed rate increase should be addressed to the Director, Bureau of Records and Hearing Services, Florida Public Service Commission, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, and that such comments should identify the docket number assigned to this proceeding.

- 2. The above stated noticing requirements are those typically found in procedural orders issued in dockets involving petitions for increases in rates. This docket does not involve a request by Florida Water to increase rates. Nor does it involve any quality of service issues. Florida Water believes that the above stated noticing provisions were inadvertently included in the Order Establishing Procedure as they have no application to the matters at issue in this docket.
- 3. Moreover, as confirmed by the Affidavit of Forrest L. Ludsen (attached hereto as Exhibit "A"), Vice President and Chief Operating Officer of Florida Water, it will cost Florida Water approximately \$40,000 to comply with the noticing requirements included in the <u>Order Establishing</u>

 <u>Procedure</u> which have no application in this docket.
- 4. Florida Water maintains that no legitimate end is served by requiring Florida Water to expend approximately \$40,000 on notice requirements that were inadvertently included in the Order Establishing Procedure and serve no legitimate purpose in this docket.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Florida Water respectfully requests that the Prehearing Officer enter an Order waiving the above described provisions Notice and Public Information provisions in the <u>Order Establishing Procedure</u>.


