
2. Seating

Staff should be seated at an elevated platform in front of the audience if at all possible. A raised bench such as we have at the Commission is best. A table may only be used if the front and sides are covered with a modesty skirt. Folding tables with an open front are appropriate only When using a modesty skirt.

A separate podium or table to one side of and facing the staff bench (away from the audience) is required for witnesses.

A second table or bench on the opposite side of the staff bench form the witness podium is required for the court reporter. If a fixed bench is not available, a table may be used provided the front and sides are covered as described above.

Mr. Wegner:

This letter is in response to your letter dated November 25, 2000. In your letter you listed the following two concerns as not being addressed in staff's recommendation. First that "the availability and cost for individual homeowners to install a separate meter for the purpose of irrigation, that is that no sewer charge would be applied to water passing through this meter" and second, "to require the utility to connect the two dead end water mains together to form a loop".

As we discussed in our informal customer meeting on October 18, 2000, staff's calculation of rates assumes that 80% of water on average is returned to the wastewater system. When asked about separate irrigation meters, staff stated that the customers could request the utility install irrigation meters, but would be required to pay the meter installation fee contained in the utility's tariff. It should be noted that on December 5, 2000, the Commission approved a meter installation fee of \$110 for a 5/8x3/4" meter fee based upon the actual cost of installing a meter as provided by the utility.

In our October meeting we also discussed a number of possible plant improvements to improve the quality of the utility's product, one of those alternatives was line looping. At the December 5, 2000, Agenda Conference, the Commission made the decision that addressing the problem of low APP CAF water pressure would require a modification to the water treatment system, and that spreading the CMP cost over a customer base of 60 connections would greatly increase the customers' rates. Because COM the utility meets Department of Environmental Protection requirements, any improvements to the CTR utility's product would be for aesthetic reasons. In this case, the Commission found that it was not ECR LEG economically feasible to remedy all of the low pressure concerns. However, if the utility's OPC customers want some of these improvements to occur and are willing to pay for these improvements PAI RGO



Mr. Thompson:

On December 5, 2000, the Commission voted on staff's recommendation dated November 20, 2000. A Proposed Agency Action (PAA) order is scheduled to be issued on December 26, 2000. If no protests are filed by the end of the protest period, which is 21 days from the date that the PAA order is issued, the rates and charges approved by this Commission will become final. However, the utility must submit revised pages for staff's approval before the utility can implement new rates.

To expedite the tariff revision process, the utility should file <u>all</u> revised tariff pages by January 17, 2001, to allow staff sufficient time to verify the accuracy of the revised pages. Enclosed are instructions for, as well as, examples of revised tariffs for this utility. Although staff has prepared revised tariffs for this utility, it is the utility's responsibility to make sure all tariffs submitted to the Commission are complete and accurate.

A copy of the customer notice informing the utility's customers of the Commission's approved increase must also be submitted for staff's review and approval. After staff approves this notice, it must be mailed to customers of receipt prior to consumption at the increased rates. This notice shall show the effective date of the tariffs. Staff has also included an example of a Commission approved customer notice.


