Dear Mr. Sundstrom:

This will acknowledge your letter of September 18, 2002. To my surprise, on the one hand you express an interest in settling, while on the other hand you choose to attack my client's credibility. For your client's sake you need to make up your mind as to which direction you want to proceed. There is no issue as to the ownership of the waste water collection system and your attempts to cast Gistro, Inc., as a trespasser were not well received by my client. My client has instructed me to advise you that the legal description contained in that deed is the section sketched out with dark lines in the top left corner of what I have marked Exhibit "A". At the time that Sheriff's Deed was issued, that property belonged to somebody else and was of no interest to my client, therefore, there was no need to fight the deed. In addition before you label my client as a trespasser, I suggest you investigate the Sheriff's authority and/or power to even issue that deed.

Therefore, if your client is seriously interested in resolving this matter he needs to stop issuing letters of availability and you need to contact my office so we can have a face to face meeting with our clients. My client would like to do this before we had a full mediation with all parties, therefore, time is of the essence.
