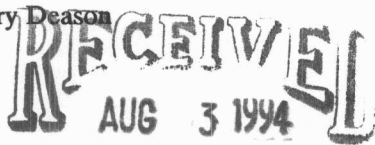

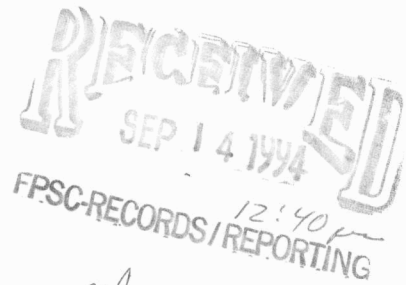

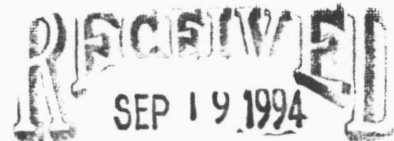

I am writing in connection with the above entitled application for P.S.C. approval of a wastewater treatment plant.

I do not understand how the application can even be acted upon, since, under the rules of the Commission, it is incomplete.

Under 25-30.033 (r), the applicant is to file "a detailed financial statement..." The applicant has submitted no such financial statement. A December 31, 1993 balance sheet was submitted as Exhibit G, showing as an asset, land of the value of one hundred and seventeen thousand dollars (\$117,000).

Resort Village Utility, Inc. was formed on October 5, 1993, and as far as I am able to determine, owned no land whatsoever on December 31, 1993.

In addition, 25-30.033 (1) (s) requires "a list of all entities upon which the applicant is relying to provide funding...which shall include their financial statements..." The only attempt to fulfill this requirement is Exhibit 1 which merely states that one Dr. Johnson and Coastal Development Consultants, Inc. will provide the funding.

The other requirements of 25-30.033 also remain unmet.



3 happen. I try to remember to look at everything.
4 Sometimes you get in a hurry and you skim something,
5 and I can't say I read every word.

6 Q. Even though you signed it, you haven't
7 necessarily read it?

8 A. Unfortunately I sign a lot of things in
9 my work, so I have to admit there are times I have not
10 read every word of what I sign.

11 Q. Did you read the application before you
12 signed it to the Department of Environmental Protection
13 for your wastewater treatment plant? Did you read it?

14 A. To the best of my recollection I did.

15 Q. Did you read your application to the
16 Public Service Commission?

17 A. Yes.

18 Q. Before you signed it for your wastewater
19 treatment plant?

20 A. Again, we have not submitted an
21 application for a plant. But if you're referring to
22 the submittal for the certificate--

23 Q. Yes.

24 A. --I have reviewed that, and I did review
25 it at the time.

1 Q. You read it before you signed it?

2 A. To the best of my recollection, yes.

3 Q. You did? Then could you tell us,
4 please, why you have the application to DEP under the
5 name of one corporation which you own and the
6 application to PSC under the name of a different one
7 that you own?

8 A. Sure. The DEP application was being
9 submitted by myself and Coastal Development
10 Consultants, as developers of the property. And that's
11 who has hired Mr. Volenec. That's who he's been
12 working with.

13 For purposes of the PSC application, we determined
14 we would set up a separate regulated utility. Our
15 alternative was to have the--have the plant operated on
16 an exempt status. We talked to DEP before this and
17 tried to determine if they had a preference, which way
18 we went. They didn't insist one way or the other, but
19 I got the impression they would prefer a regulated
20 status, because it gave an additional regulatory handle
21 or--or hammer, shall you say, over the plant.

22 That you would have the--in essence, you'd have
23 capital invested in that plant, and you'd have the
24 owners that would be concerned about maintaining that
25 capital and maintaining that license. So that's the

1 way we structured it. We structured it as a regulated
2 utility with substantial capital commitments to it.

3 And to do that, under the PSC regulations, the
4 logical way to do it was as a separate company to be
5 regulated by the PSC. And it's clear--our intent, I
6 believe, it's in the documentation submitted to PSC--
7 the intention is, if and when we get a permit from DEP,
8 we'll simply assign that permit to the regulated
9 utility. Assuming that the PSC grants the regulated
10 utility the right to have a certificate. If for some
11 reason they didn't give us that right, then we would
12 instead assign the permit to an exempt organization.

13 Q. Now, as you recall Mr. May testifying
14 that one of the things you still have to produce for
15 DEP is a certificate from the Public Service
16 Commission; is that correct? Do you recall that?

17 A. Yes. In fact, I have the impression
18 that, that is the major, if not the only, remaining
19 item before our permit application will be declared
20 complete, based on the documentation that's coming back
21 to us.

22 We started out with page after, page after, page
23 of things they wanted. And we kept trying to give them
24 what they wanted, and they'd clarify, and they'd add,
25 and they--you know, we'd keep submitting material. But

1 that list kept getting shorter, and shorter, and
2 shorter. And our latest communications from DEP, from
3 Mr. May, essentially lists that as the major remaining,
4 if not the only, remaining hurdle.

5 So, we either need a certificate from the PSC or,
6 again, we would have to go as an exempt organization.
7 One or the other, they need to know which it is and
8 then that needs--that needs to be clarified.

9 We never expected that to take long, to be honest
10 with you. We expected that to take a couple of months
11 and that it was a relatively routine matter, but we
12 were confident we would have it done by the time DEP
13 was ready.

14 As it turns out, objections to--were filed with
15 PSC, and then PSC had a turnover of personnel and those
16 objections have never been resolved for many, many
17 months, and then it finally started moving. And we now
18 expect within the next four months, based on their
19 statutory requirements to resolve the issue one way or
20 the other with the PSC.

21 Q. So, Coastal Development is awaiting,
22 among other things perhaps, but primarily a certificate
23 from PSC to get your permit from DEP; is that correct?

24 A. That's roughly correct. In other words,
25 DEP, before they can announce their intent to issue a

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1 permit--which doesn't mean you've got the permit--but
2 they announce it, they publicize it, there's newspaper
3 advertisements, or whatever, and there's one last
4 chance for the public to comment and to critique it.
5 Before they can make that announcement, we first have
6 to resolve is it going to be operated by a PSC
7 regulated entity or an exempt entity.

8 Q. And the last thing that you are waiting
9 for, in your words, is Coastal Development Consultants,
10 Inc.'s certificate from PSC. You give them that at
11 DEP, and you get your permits?

12 A. No. That's not precisely what I'm
13 saying. And it's important. I need to correct you.
14 We're waiting to see whether the Resort Village
15 Utility, Inc. will be certificated by the PSC as a
16 regulated utility. If they turn it down, then that
17 basically--we have to go back to the beginning of the
18 process, start over and amend the application to DEP to
19 announce a different entity which would be an exempt
20 entity. We could have done that in the very
21 beginning, but there were some pros and cons, as I say.

22 The reason we chose the PSC route is, we got the
23 feeling from DEP that they would prefer that. Not they
24 were insisting on it, but they had, had some negative
25 experiences with homeowners associations and those

1 kinds of exempt organizations. And they had, had,
2 although not always good experiences, they've had
3 better experiences with regulated utilities.

4 And we were--again, our whole philosophy here has
5 been one of exceeding the regulatory requirements
6 whenever we could, trying to meet the agencies and give
7 them not only what they would require, but what they
8 would like to see where it's feasible.

9 Q. Could the stenographer read my question
10 back to Mr. Johnson? It's a long way back.

11 COURT REPORTER: I believe this is it.

12 "Question: So, Coastal Development is
13 awaiting, among other things perhaps, but
14 primarily a certificate from PSC to get your
15 permit from DEP; is that correct?"

16 MR. WILLIAMS: I think he's answered the
17 question, Your honor.

18 Q. (By Mr. Tobin) I think we got a speech,
19 not an answer.

20 A. No, the Resort Village utility is
21 waiting to see if it will be receiving a certificate.
22 If that entity fails, then Coastal will pursue the
23 permit with DEP, using a different exempt entity.

24 Q. But if you bring down approval from PSC
25 to DEP for Coastal, that will solve your basic problem

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1 with DEP; is that correct?

2 A. That's going a little too far. This is
3 an ongoing review process. If they receive new
4 information, maybe they'll ask for something new. All
5 I can say is that we've gone from a very lengthy list
6 of requests that resulted in a great deal of
7 expenditure of funds and a great deal of additional
8 information to our current status where there is really
9 nothing technical outstanding.

10 We have the PSC item and one or two other
11 procedural-type items that we think we have cleared up.
12 That's all I know. I--I can't say for sure that DEP is
13 going to issue us a permit, but I feel a lot more
14 encouraged today than I did a year ago.

15 Q. I didn't ask you if they were. But in
16 any event, should you get approval from the Public
17 Service Commission, you'll be bringing down to them an
18 approval not for Coastal Development Consultants, Inc.,
19 but for Resort Village Utility, Inc.; isn't that so?

20 A. For this particular plant to serve this
21 particular certificated area, that's correct.

22 MR. TOBIN: No questions, Your Honor.

23 MR. SHULER: I have no questions.

24 THE COURT: Redirect?

25 MR. WILLIAMS: None, Your Honor.

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1 familiar with the subcontractors familiar with the best

4 And that's basically our goal. And I think we've
5 been achieving that with Eagle. Eagle is currently in
6 operation and is serving the local market building
7 single-family houses--

8 Q. Around Franklin County?

9 A. I think to date all of the work has been
10 on the island, but certainly they're available to work
11 anywheres in Franklin County if there were a job
12 available. But to the moment, I think they've
13 concentrated on the island.

14 Q. I see. And you are a part owner of that
15 you said?

16 A. Yes.

17 Q. And an officer?

18 A. Yes.

19 Q. I see. O.K. Now, do you recognize this
20 document, Doctor?

21 A. Yes.

22 Q. What is it?

23 A. It's a declaration of covenants,
24 conditions, and restrictions for The Bluffs.

25 Q. What's the name of it?

1 A. I'm not sure what you're asking.

2 Q. Section One, association shall mean
3 what?

4 A. O.K. Midway down the page it says,
5 "Section One, Association shall mean and refer to The
6 Bluffs Homeowners Association, Inc., a Florida
7 non-profit corporation, it's successors and assigns."

8 Q. Which you formed?

9 A. Yes.

10 Q. All right. And you formed it. It was
11 in existence then. You formed it yourself?

12 A. I'm not sure I understand. I'm the
13 declarant. My attorneys drafted the language.

14 Q. But you formed at some--this was filed
15 on August 28, 1992; is that correct?

16 A. Yes. It's--essentially was part of the
17 subdivision process for The--The Bluffs. We
18 established a set of documents in anticipation of
19 selling individual lots.

20 It--this document, for example, establishes
21 architectural controls for the property, it establishes
22 environmental controls. And also, it assures a
23 relationship back to the adjacent property that I own
24 in Resort Village, so that--for example, we had set
25 aside some green space in The Bluffs, analogous to what

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1 we plan to do in the remainder of the Resort Village--
2 I wanted to be sure I had a--there was notice and it
3 was clear that we had a right to protect that green
4 space for our benefit, as well as the benefit of the 10
5 owners who bought those 10 lots.

6 Q. O.K. So, you formed this association
7 and then filed these covenants; is that correct?

8 A. Yes.

9 MR. TOBIN: I would offer these, Your
10 Honor.

11 THE COURT: Identified as Respondent's
12 (sic) 6. Any objection?

13 MR. WILLIAMS: None.

14 THE COURT: It's admitted.

15 (Intervenor's Exhibit No. 6 admitted into

17 Q. (By Mr. Tobin) When did you file The
18 Bluffs Homeowners Association, Doctor?

24 I don't really remember the details. I do recall that
25 we started the subdivision process, getting platted,

5 the agreement--the covenants?

19 Franklin County registry; did you not?

20 A. Again, I don't recall the sequence of
21 events, but we did file actually two plats, a Phase I
22 and then a Phase II plat.

23 Q. O.K. I think I'm holding them both
24 here. Is this Phase I?

25 A. Yes.

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1 Q. When is that dated? Your oath was taken
2 on it. It would be--

3 A. Apparently it was pre--it was signed on
4 August 28th. It looks as though it was prepared a few
5 days earlier. August 19 is when it was prepared by the
6 engineers, or at least initially came out of their CAD
7 system.

8 Q. And what does that--

9 A. I see a subsequent date. Excuse me,
10 there's a whole bunch--all sorts of dates here.

15 Q. This is dated August 28th. What does
16 that say?

17 A. "Cause said lands to be divided and

21 and/or his assigns, shall be maintained by The Bluffs
22 Homeowners Association. No part of the land shown
23 hereon shall be deemed to have been dedicated to the

3 Q. And that is your signature there?

4 A. Yes.

5 Q. Ben Johnson?

7 Q. And you gave it an acknowledgement down
8 here signed by Morris Palmer; is that correct?

9 A. Apparently he was the notary on it.

10 Q. Now, you went and filed another one in
11 January. Is this that document?

12 A. It appears to be Phase II.

13 Q. What date in January did you sign it?

14 A. It appears to be the 29th of January.

15 Q. Of what year?

16 A. 1993.

17 Q. After all these other things were done;
18 is that correct?

19 A. After whatever happened. I mean, I'm
20 not sure what you're asking me, but yes--

21 Q. After the--

22 A. --the date is January of '93.




