Can't you do anything to stop the unbridled arrogance of Florida Water Services (FWS)? On May 11, Tropical Isles (TI) residents received an undated notice from FWS announcing "initiation of limited proceeding to restructure [emph. added] FWS wastewater rates for TI" ... It went on to say that a meeting with TI residents would be in "late May or early June"; this, of course and not coincidentally, being when many TI residents are not in Florida.

PSC's original directive (October 1996) to SSU/FWS was to see if water-use data could readily be obtained from Fort Pierce Utilities Authority (FPUA), so a fair rate for wastewater-only service could be determined. After stating such was not feasible, FWS admitted it could easily obtain data from FPUA.

How can PSC staff allow FWS to issue a memo with information contrary to the Commission's order? FWS tries to have readers accept the fact that the total amount due FWS for TI services is set; that only varying rates among residents based upon regular and vacation usage is still open. THIS IS NOT THE COMMISSION'S ORDER. FWS WAS TOLD TO GET DATA FROM FPUA SO A FAIR RATE COULD BE DETERMINED FOR T.I. BECAUSE OF A UNIQUE SITUATION!

FWS' rate for TI is far too high. FWS staff comments during the 1996 hearings indicated less than \$20.00 per month per residence -- A \$5.00 increase would turn a profit for FWS. The current move by FWS shows its typical arrogance and contempt for good customer relations. It is a "three shells and the pea" game to make certain unwarranted assumptions to try to get a confiscatory rate from people with a fixed income.

Enough is enough! Stop this rogue company from its constant management, legal and lobbying manipulation and pressures. It appears that PSC staff tries to find ways to help FWS get more money. Even when FWS was directed to consult about a fair rate for TI, this memorandum is the result. Return the TI rate to the original \$13.33 per resident per month that it was plus any increase which the company shows is necessary to make a profit at Tropical Istes; namely, the \$5.00 per month according to their own statements.

Attached is the information that you requested via letter dated November 13, 1997 concerning the billing analysis prepared for this docket. As you can see half of the water removed from the billing analysis is water used at the Florida Water Services wastewater plant in Tropical Isles. The remaining gallons were removed because we do not have the properties supplied by the Ft. Pierce Utility Authority listed as current customers. Field personnel checked the addresses of these properties and could not verify at the time that those addresses were occupied residences.

I have also attached an additional billing analysis and rate design sheet that includes the gallons previously excluded as described above, except for the gallons attributable to the wastewater plant. This information is being supplied for informational purposes only. Note that the addition of these gallons and bills does not change the rates significantly, mainly because of the 6,000 cap per bill used for the attached rate design.

Please advise me of any recommendations or questions you have regarding this information. Florida Water is willing to conduct such further examination of these matters as is reasonable.


