Docket No. 050159-TL - Petition for expedited review of growth code denails by

Number Pooling Administrator for Port St. Lucie exchange (Main), by BellSouth

Telecommunications, Inc.

On February 21, 2005, BellSouth Telecommunications submitted a code request application to NeuStar for two (2) 1,000 blocks of numbers for the Port St. Lucie exchange, in their Main (PTSLFLMADS0) switch. These number blocks have been requested in order to provide for growth numbering resources for the office. Also on February 21, 2005, NeuStar denied BellSouth's application because it did not meet the utilization criteria required for a new block of numbers, based on the FCC's month-to-exhaust (MTE) formula.

On March 3, 2005, BellSouth filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision to deny numbering resources in the Main (PTSLFLMADS0) switch, located at the Port St. Lucie rate center. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL (Docket No. 020087-TL), which approved an expedited process for NeuStar code denials, we have examined the BellSouth petition, along with the confidential supplemental information, and have determined the following:

1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has customers in need of numbering resources; CMP The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to potential customers because of NeuStar's denial of numbering resources; COM CTR \_\_\_\_\_3) Customers will not be able to obtain the service from the provider of his/her choice ECR because the carrier will not have the numbers available. GCL

Since the three criteria of Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order to be issued within seven business days or this memorandum (March 18, 2004), as outlined in the expedited code denial process orders. NeuStar should be directed to provide BellSouth the needed numbering resources to meet its RCA \_\_\_customer's needs in the Main switch (PTSLFLMADS0), specifically for two (2) 1,000 blocks of numbers.
