On April 25, 2006, Sprint-Florida, Inc. (Sprint) filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar), for the Kissimmee exchange, Kissimmee (KSSMFLXAPSO) switch. Sprint requested a full NXX code to meet a specific customer's request. On May 2, 2006, Sprint's request for a full NXX code of numbers was denied because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust utilization criteria required for additional numbering resources.

On May 10, 2006, Sprint filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the Sprint petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources;
2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
3) The customer will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (May 31, 2006), as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide Sprint the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Kissimmee exchange, Kissimmee (KSSMFLXAPSO) switch.
