### AT&T FLORIDA'S REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida"), and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Sections 364.183 and 364.24, files its Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

- 1. On August 9, 2007, AT&T Florida filed its Responses and Objections to dPi's First Request for Information. AT&T Florida's response to Request Nos. 1-3, 1-16, and 1-17 contains customer specific information for dPi Teleconnect, Inc. that is confidential business information. AT&T's response to Request No. 1-22 contains AT&T information that is confidential business information. AT&T Florida filed a Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification regarding these proprietary materials on the same day that it responded to the above-described discovery.
- 2. AT&T Florida hereby files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification because the above-referenced information is confidential business information that could cause competitive harm to dPi and/or AT&T Florida, and is confidential and proprietary under Florida Statutes, Sections 364.183 and 364.24.
- 3. Attachment A to AT&T Florida's Request for Confidential Classification contains an explanation of the proprietary information along with a list that identifies the location of the information designated by AT&T as confidential.

- 4. Attachment B to AT&T Florida's Request for Confidential Classification is two redacted copies of the confidential information.
- 5. Attachment C to AT&T Florida's Request for Confidential Classification is a proprietary copy of the confidential information, highlighted to clearly indicate the proprietary material.
- 6. Public disclosure of this information would provide competitors of AT&T Florida and dPi with an unfair marketing advantage. Such proprietary information is not available to the general public. The information discussed in this Request for Specified Confidential Classification is valuable and both AT&T Florida and dPi strive to keep it secret. Therefore, such information should be classified as confidential business information and customer proprietary information pursuant to Section 364.24 and Section 364.183(3)(e), Florida Statutes. Accordingly, it should be held exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.
- 6. AT&T Florida has treated, and intends to continue to treat, the information for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed.
- 7. The original of this Request was filed today with the Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services and a copy was served on the Parties.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, AT&T Florida respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential, proprietary business information that is not subject to public disclosure.

#### **Explanation of Proprietary Information**

- 1. The proprietary material included in this document is customer specific information. In particular, the proprietary information details by account, by month, the billing activity of one of AT&T's customers. Such information is deemed by AT&T Florida and by AT&T Florida's customer, dPi Teleconnect, L.L.C. to be competitively sensitive and proprietary information. The Commission has always zealously protected customer specific information in order to protect the customer's privacy and prevent a competitor of the customer from obtaining an unfair advantage. This information should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(e), Florida Statutes and is exempt from the Open Records Act.
- 2. The proprietary material included in this document is end user customer specific information. In particular, the proprietary information consists of phone numbers and/or addresses of dPi's end users. Such information is deemed by AT&T Florida to be proprietary information of AT&T Florida's customer, dPi Teleconnect, and it is also customer information that is proprietary to dPi. The Commission has always zealously protected customer specific information in order to protect the customer's privacy and to prevent a competitor of the customer from obtaining an unfair advantage. This information is also expressly deemed to be confidential pursuant to Sections 364.183(3)(e) and 364.24, Florida Statutes.
- 3. The proprietary material included in this document consists of email and P-3 forms that document AT&T Florida's market planning processes and provide product analysis used to develop and roll out a retail promotion. This same information on competitors is not available to AT&T Florida. This information is valuable, it is used by AT&T Florida in conducting its business and AT&T Florida strives to keep it secret. Therefore, this information should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(a), Florida Statutes and is exempt from the Open Records Act.
