RE: **AT&T Florida's Request For Specified Confidential Classification in Docket No. 060822-TL** - Petition for relief from carrier-of-last-resort (COLR) obligations pursuant to Florida Statutes 364.025(6)(d) for two private subdivisions in Nocatee development, by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.
FPSC Document No. 07604-07 (cross reference DN 06245-07)

On August 24, 2007, AT&T Florida filed its Request For Specified Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C. and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, for certain information contained in FPSC Document No. 07604-07: Nocatee's *Supplemental Response to AT&T Florida's Second Request for Production of Documents, Item No. 10.*

On August 14, 2007, Nocatee filed its Request for Confidential Treatment for the same document, FPSC Document No. 06245-07, and advised that AT&T Florida should file the appropriate request for confidential classification for the copy it filed: FPSC Document No. 07604-07.

AT&T Florida claims the information in Document No. 07604-07 for which confidential classification is requested contains confidential, trade secret business information related to the competitive interests of AT&T Florida that is proprietary to AT&T Florida and has not been disclosed to the public. AT&T Florida claims that public disclosure of this information would impair its competitive business interests and cause harm to AT&T Florida. The information subject to the request for confidential classification relates to AT&T Florida's proposed custom deal terms and pricing with a developer. The information also contains proposals regarding architecture, technology and timelines for deployment of facilities.
