RE: Tampa Electric Company and Progress Energy Florida's request for confidential Classification

On August 1, 2007, Tampa Electric Company (TECO) and Progress Energy Florida (PEF) filed their petition to Determine Need for Electrical Transmission Line in Docket No. 070393-EI. TECO and PEF incorporating by reference therein, the supporting joint prefiled direct testimony and exhibits of Brantley Tillis of PEF and Thomas J. Szelistowski of TECO.

On August 1, 2007, TECO and PEF filed a single confidential version of the prefiled Exhibit FT/TJS-10 to the Joint Prefiled Direct Testimony of Brantley Tillis of PEF and Thomas J. Szelistowski of TECO with the Commission. TECO and PEF stated that the unredacted pages of prefiled Exhibit FT/TJS-10 that are highlighted in yellow contains critical energy infrastructure information and ask that it be treated as confidential proprietary business information as defined under Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes.

Staff has reviewed TECO and PEF's prefiled Exhibit FT/TJS-10 to the Joint Prefiled Direct Testimony of Brantley Tillis of PEF and Thomas J. Szelistowski of TECO. This exhibit contains information on TECO and PEF's energy infrastructure that staff believes would be of little value to assist the Commission in reaching its decision. Therefore, Staff recommends that this exhibit be returned to TECO and PEF.
