

Re: Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") Sunshine Energy® Program Staff Request for Information

Dear Ms. Cole:

This letter is written in response to Staff's request for information regarding the status of solar projects constructed (or caused to be constructed) by FPL's Sunshine Energy Program. A notice of intent to seek confidential classification for the highlighted portions of this letter is being filed concurrent with this response.

FPL's Sunshine Energy® program reached the 10,000 customer increment milestones on the following dates:


10,000 customers: January 2005 20,000 customers: July 2005 30,000 customers: February 2007

Thus, the Program's obligation is a total of 450 kW of solar capacity.

The status of various solar projects for the Sunshine Energy® program is currently as follows:

- 1. Rothenbach Park, Sarasota (250 kW): Installation of a 250 kW solar facility at Rothenbach Park, Sarasota County, Florida is expected to be completed in October 2007. The 1,200 PV panels (providing 250 kW of solar capacity) have been installed at the site. The only remaining work is interconnection with the grid.
- 2. <u>The Quarry, Centex Homes, Naples (54kW)</u>: 54kW of solar arrays on new homes constructed in a subdivision in the FPL service territory have been installed.
- 3. <u>Miami Science Museum (2 kW)</u>: A 2 kW solar facility has already been installed at the Miami Science Museum. The array was completed in April 2007.
- 4. <u>SunSmart Schools projects (8 kW)</u>: Three 2 kW projects have been installed at three different schools: the M.A.S.T. Academy and South Miami Senior High, in Miami; and

Palm City Elementary School, in Palm City. An additional 2 kW project (for a total of 8 kW) has been installed at Edgewood Jr./Sr. High School, Merritt Island, and should be operational beginning in October 2007. The Program funded more than half the remaining cost for each project, beyond the SunSmart Schools award amount.



A total of 314 kW of solar capacity should be installed by October, 2007.

The FPL Sunshine Energy® solar program is unique among the more than 700 utility green power programs in the nation. The Sunshine Energy® program is ranked third in the nation for residential customer participation by the U.S. Department of Energy's National Renewable Energy Laboratory. We believe that the solar capacity which has been installed as part of the Sunshine Energy® program may serve as an inspiration to programs in other states.
