3. Pursuant to Order No. PSC-07-0469-NOR-WS issued May 31, 2007, the Commission

issued notice of its intent to adopt new Rule 25-30.4325, Florida Administrative Code, relating to water treatment plant used and useful calculations.

4. On June 29, 2007, the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") filed a Petition for A Formal

Administrative Hearing pursuant to subsection 120.54(3)(c)2., Florida Statutes, concerning the

formal hearing pursuant to Order No. PSC-07-0741-PCO-WS issued September 17, 2007.

5. This proceeding will focus on the adoption of a Rule standardizing the methodology for establishing the used and useful calculations for water treatment plants. As the Petitioner, OPC bears the burden of demonstrating that the Commission should not adopt Staff's proposed Rule 25-30.4325. AUF's substantial interests are affected by the proposed Rule in that it owns and operates over 80 water and wastewater systems in Florida to which this proposed Rule will be applicable.

6. AUF received notice of the Commission decision to conduct a formal hearing verbally at the Commission's August 28, 2007, Agenda, and by receipt of Commission Order No. PSC-07-0741-PCO-WS, upon its issuance on September 17, 2007.

7. Proposed Rule 25-30.4325 is the result of the give and take of a Staff Workshop and the consideration of comments filed by interested parties. While AUF has concerns with specific provisions in proposed Rule 25-30.4325, AUF supports the proposed Rule as a whole if it is adopted in toto. At this time, AUF is not aware of any disputed issues of material fact, subject to disputed issues of material fact which may be raised through the initial prefiled direct testimony of Petitioner OPC.

8. AUF supports the proposed Rule, thus does not allege any facts warranting reversal or modification of the proposed Rule.

9. AUF supports the proposed Rule and knows of no specific statutes or rules which would require reversal or modification of the proposed Rule.

10. AUF seeks this Commission's adoption of the proposed Rule in its current form.

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WHEREFORE, AUF requests this Commission to grant it intervention in the docket with

full party status equal to that of OPC.
