On August 29, 2007, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida filed its Request for Specified Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C. and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, for certain information contained in FPSC Document No. 08515-07. AT&T Florida references documents previously identified as FPSC Document Nos. 06937-07 and 07027-07.

On September 18, 2007, AT&T Florida filed an amended Request for specified confidential classification for its response to Staff's First Request for Production of Documents, item No. 5. This document has been identified as FPSC Document No. 08515-07. On October 11, 2007, AT&T Florida filed a letter indicating it had discovered a typographical error in its September 18, 2007 filing. AT&T requests that its September 18, 2007, "Attachment A" filing be replaced with its October 11, 2007, "Attachment A."
