Dear Mr. Friedman:

Pursuant to Order No. PSC-07-0505-SC-WS, issued on June 13, 2007, and consummated by Order No. PSC-07-0566-CO-WS, issued on July 9, 2007, the utility was required to make refunds for excessive interim water revenues collected in Orange, Pasco, Pinellas, and Seminole Counties. The Commission specifically found that the utility should refund the following percentages of interim water revenues: 100% for Orange County; 4.20% for Pasco County; 9.20% for Pinellas County; and 8.16% for Seminole County.

Before the docket can be closed and the corporate undertaking can be released, staff must verify that the appropriate refunds with interest has been accomplished. Despite repeated calls by staff, the utility has failed to provide the required documentation. Please have the utility provide the required documentation concerning the refunds by November 26, 2007. If the utility fails to provide the required information by November 26, 2007, staff will proceed with a show cause recommendation.
