MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

COMES NOW Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPUC" or "Company"), by and through its undersigned pursuant to Rule 28-106.108, Florida Administrative Code, and files this Motion to Consolidate these dockets and as a basis states:

- 1. On July 3, 2007, FPUC filed its Storm Hardening Plan for approval in Docket No. 070300-EI. Thereafter on August 30, 2007, FPUC filed its Petition for Rate Relief in Docket No. 070304-EI. Both dockets are currently pending.
- 2. In the Storm Plan docket, the Commission has before it for review and approval, the plan submitted as required by Rule 25-06.0342, Florida Administrative Code. This also includes the storm initiatives previously filed and approved by the Commission for FPUC. Cost recovery is not part of the review process for the Storm Plan docket, and FPUC has included as part of its requested rate increase in the rate proceeding, additional revenue to recover the costs of the storm plan as filed. Thus, approval of the plan is in one docket while the cost recovery associated with the plan is part of another.
- 3. The two dockets are so intertwined with each other that it would be more efficient for the disposition of theses dockets to consolidate them for all purposes. In Order No. PSC-07-

0647-PCO-EI, issued August 9, 2007, the Prehearing Officer acknowledged the overlap of the dockets and ordered consolidation for the evidentiary hearing. On December 5, 2007, the

Commission issued Order No. PSC-07-0969-PCO-EI the Prehearing Officer determined that

parties to both dockets could rely upon "any and all evidence adduced" in either docket in the

other.

4. FPUC requests that these dockets be consolidated for all purposes and that any

and all filings made in either docket to date be part of the consolidated record and that further

filing - including testimony - be similarly treated. Consolidation would facilitate disposition of

these dockets and be a more efficient procedure. FPUC does not believe any party would be

unduly prejudiced by granting this request.

5. Counsel for FPUC has contacted each party to the two dockets and advised them

in conversation or by message of the intent to file this motion.

For the reasons given, FPUC requests the Commission to grant the Motion to

Consolidate.
