

**JOINT PETITION OF AT&T FLORIDA
AND WINDSTREAM FLORIDA, INC. (formerly known as Alltel
Florida, Inc.) TO TRANSFER TERRITORIES IN ST. JOHNS
COUNTY AND TO AMEND CERTIFICATES**

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida (“AT&T Florida”) and Windstream Florida, Inc. (formerly known as Alltel Florida, Inc.) (“Windstream”) pursuant to Rules 25-4.005 and 28.106.201, Florida Administrative Code, jointly petition the Florida Public Service Commission (the “Commission” or “FPSC”) to modify certain exchange boundaries in St. Johns County and to amend the companies’ certificates accordingly. In support of this petition, AT&T Florida and Windstream state as follows:

1. AT&T Florida is an incumbent local exchange company lawfully doing business in the State of Florida, the regulated operations of which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Chapter 364, Florida Statutes. AT&T Florida provides service in Florida under FPSC Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 8.

2. Windstream is an incumbent local exchange company lawfully doing business in the State of Florida, the regulated operations of which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Chapter 364, Florida Statutes. Windstream

6. By this petition, AT&T Florida and Windstream seek to amend the exchange boundaries to transfer the portion of the Bartram Farms Subdivision in the AT&T Florida St. Johns Exchange to the Windstream Hastings Exchange. The territory to be transferred consists of all or a portion of approximately 70 platted lots in the Bartram Farms Subdivision. The territorial boundary between AT&T and Windstream

was established before the subdivision was platted and this proposed transfer will adjust the boundaries to put the entire subdivision in Windstream's territory. A copy of a map showing the current and proposed boundaries is attached as Exhibit "A".

7. The boundary change will promote economy and efficiency by making the boundary easier to administer and for the public to understand and therefore is in the public interest.

8. There are no customers currently taking service in the portion of territory to be transferred.

9. There are no pending applications for basic local service held by AT&T Florida or Windstream related to the territory to be transferred.

10. AT&T Florida does not currently hold any deposits or deposit interest for the customers in the area to be transferred.

11. Upon the Commission's approval of the modifications proposed herein, the parties will file the final tariff sheets for administrative approval.


12. No financial exchange or consideration was, or shall be, given for this proposed transfer of Certificated Areas. This Joint Application is the only written agreement between the applicants.

13. Both AT&T Florida and Windstream have agreed that the requested transfer of service area is feasible from an economic standpoint and beneficial to the subscribers of both companies.

14. Pursuant to FPSC Rule 25-4.005, the required affidavits are attached to this Joint Petition as Exhibit "B", and certify that notice of intention to file the Petition has been given to those parties set forth in the above cited rule.



Opening lead — king of diamonds.

There are times when declarer is playing a contract that seems impossible to make. There are also times when a defender finds it impossible to defend successfully. When both of these conditions happen to coincide, a victor must necessarily emerge from the clash.

Take this case where South was in 5♣ parts and West led the K-A-Q of diamonds. Declarer ruffed and South could not club losers. Obviously, this seems impossible to make. But South

managed the affair very well and made the contract, and East-West found themselves helpless in the matter.

Declarer began by playing the A-K-Q of trumps, producing this position:

South next led the jack of trumps, and it was this play that knocked West out of the box. If he discarded a spade, declarer would throw a club from dummy, then cash the A-K of spades and ruff a spade, establishing the ten as a trick. A club lead toward dummy's queen would then allow South to score the ten of spades and queen of clubs as the game-going tricks.

If West instead discarded the nine of clubs on the jack of trumps, declarer would discard a spade from dummy and then lead a club to limit himself to one club loser.

Either way, South would get home with 10 tricks.
