South next led the jack of trumps, and it was this play that knocked West out of the box. If he discarded a spade, declarer would throw a club from dummy, then eash the A-K of spades and ruff a spade, establishing the ten as a trick. A club lead toward duminy's queen would then allow South to score the ten of spades and queen of clubs as the game-going tricks.

If West instead discarded the nine of clubs on the jack of trumps declarer would discard a spade from dummy and then lead a club to limit himself to one club loser.

Either way, South would get home $T_{P_{i},T_{i}}$
