2	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Good afternoon.
3	We'll go ahead and call this prehearing to order, and
4	I'll begin by asking our staff to read the notice.
5	MS. POBLETE: Pursuant to notice issued May 2nd,
6	2008, this time and place has been set for a prehearing
7	conference in Docket Number 000475-TP, complaint by BellSouth
8	Telecommunications against Thrifty Call regarding practices in
9	the reporting of percent interstate usage for compensation for
10	jurisdictional access services.
11	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Thank you. And we'll take
12	appearances.
13	MR. GURDIAN: Good afternoon, Commissioner Edgar.
14	Manny Gurdian on behalf of AT&T Florida.
15	MR. McDONNELL: Marty McDonnell on behalf of
16	Thrifty Call.
17	MS. POBLETE: Charlene Poblete and Rick Mann on
18	behalf of Commission Staff.
19	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Thank you.
20	And, Chris, do we have anybody by phone?
21	Okay. Let the record reflect that there is nobody by
22	phone.
23	Okay. Any preliminary matters before we walk our way
24	through the draft prehearing order?
25	MS. POBLETE: There are none at this time.
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1	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay.
2	Any other procedural matters that you would like to
3	take up at this time?
4	MS. POBLETE: No, Commissioner.
5	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: And to our parties, anything
6	before we go into the draft order?
7	MR. GURDIAN: Commissioner Edgar, we have some
8	motions to compel. I understand you're going to rule on those
9	later on at the hearing.
10	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: From my discussions with staff
11	earlier, it's my understanding that their recommendation is
12	that we keep those rulings forthcoming on the motions to compel
13	and deal with them separately. Is my understanding, correct?
14	MS. POBLETE: That is correct, Commissioner.
15	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Then that is the way we will
16	handle that. Thank you for raising it.
17	Mr. McDonnell, anything?
18	MR. McDONNELL: Nothing from Thrifty Call. Thank
19	you.
20	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Then let's just go through it
21	page-by-page and Roman Numeral-by-Roman Numeral. We'll have
22	the draft order.
23	Issue I, case background; Roman Numeral I. No
24	changes.
25	II, conduct of proceedings. No changes.

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1	III, jurisdiction. No changes.
2	IV, procedure for confidential information.
3	V, prefiled testimony, exhibits and witnesses. No
4	changes.
5	Order of witnesses. Any issues with the order of
6	witnesses as they are currently listed? Any possibility of
7	stipulating any witnesses?
8	MR. McDONNELL: I haven't discussed it with
9	Mr. Gurdian, but I don't imagine that there is.
10	MR. GURDIAN: I'll have to discuss it with my client,
11	Commissioner, but we haven't discussed it at all, so
12	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: So we will leave it as it is for
13	the time being.
14	Yes, ma'am, did you have a question, comment? No.
15	Okay.
16	VII, positions, overall positions. No change.
17	VIII, issue-by-issue positions.
18	IX, the exhibit list as reflected in this draft

23	XIV, this recommends opening statements be limited to
24	five minutes per party. Is there a request for opening

18	COMMISSIONER EDGAR: That is my understanding. But,
19	again, I will look to staff, and they are nodding. Nodding
20	affirmatively, let me add.
