RE: Request for Expedited NPA-NXX Relief for the ReedyCreek Rate Center with Confidential Treatment of Certain Customer and Company Data

Dear Ms. Bayó:

US LEC of Florida Inc., d/b/a PAETEC Business Services (Company) seeks expedited review and intervention of the Commission in securing an NPA-NXX assignment for customer use in the ReedyCreek Rate Center. The Company, recently requested one 1000 block of numbers (1,000 numbers) for the ReedyCreek rate center from NeuStar. The impetus for the request was the need for a block of numbers to support a customer that desired 1,000 numbers (confidential customer letter attached) to support its business operations, building of a new 300 room hotel.

On May 13, 2008, the Company requested 1,000 numbering resources from NeuStar. Attached is a copy of the latest Company request for numbering resources issued to NeuStar (three pages). Also attached is a copy of the utilization data that is a part of that request (two pages). NeuStar rejected the 1,000 block on the basis that the Company had not met the MTE and/or Utilization requirements. Additionally, as supplemental documentation, confidential copy of the Company's internal documentation of its utilization in the ReedyCreek rate center is enclosed.

The Company does not have the NPA-NXX resources in the ReedyCreek Rate Center sufficient to provide the requested 1,000 consecutive numbers requested by its customer. The Company is unable to provide the services requested by its customer because of NeuStar's failure to supply all of the necessary resources, a block of 1,000 consecutive numbers. Because of NeuStar's failure to assign the required numbering resources, the customer cannot obtain service for the block of 1,000 telephone numbers from the Company, the customer's provider of choice.

US LEC requests that the Commission intervene on its behalf to secure a block of 1,000 consecutive numbers in the NPA 407 from Neustar, in the 4xxx, 6xxx -7xxx range. The customer's project begins in October, 2008. In accordance with FCC orders and NeuStar's Central Office Code Guidelines, provide that state regulatory authorities have the power and authority to review NeuStar's decision to deny a request for numbering resources.

This claim of confidentiality was filed by or on behalf of a "telco" for Confidential DN 04895-08. The document is in locked storage pending advice on handling. To access the material, your name must be on the CASR. If undocketed, your division director must provide written permission before you can access it.
