FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S AMENDMENTS TO REQUESTS FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

NOW, BEFORE THIS COMMISSION, through undersigned counsel, comes Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") and, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006 of the Florida Administrative Code and section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, hereby amends the Requests for Confidential Classification previously filed in this docket on August 31, 2007, October 18, 2007, March 24, 2008, and June 19, 2008. In support of its request, FPL states as follows:

- 1. FPL has filed requests for confidential classification on the above mentioned dates. At the time of those filings, the information for which confidential classification was requested had not been publicly disclosed by FPL or Green Mountain Energy Company. Subsequently, Green Mountain agreed to make public certain of its competitively sensitive information and contractual data which otherwise would be afforded confidential classification pursuant to section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. Accordingly, FPL is amending the four requests for confidential classification listed above to reflect the recent public disclosure of information that previously constituted confidential proprietary business information under section 366.093(3) of the Florida Statutes.
- 2. The Requests for Confidential Classification filed on August 31, 2007, October 18, 2007, March 24, 2008, and June 19, 2008, along with Exhibits A, B, and D thereto, are included herein by reference and are not intended to be superseded by this amendment to those filings, other than as described herein. By this amendment, FPL is waiving its request for

confidential classification for some of the information included in those filings, as described below. Each of the original Exhibit Cs are intended to be superseded by and replaced with the Revised Exhibit Cs described below.

Each "Amendment to Exhibit B" provides the pages of the original Exhibit B on which information was previously redacted and is now publicly available. Accordingly, only the pages of the original Exhibit B that have changed are included in each Amendment.

4. FPL submits that the information identified in the Revised Exhibit Cs continues to be proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes, for the reasons set forth in the original requests and as supported by the affidavits included in each previously filed Exhibit D. To the best of FPL's knowledge, this

information has not been publicly disclosed. Pursuant to section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.

5. Upon a finding by the Commission that the material identified in the Revised Exhibit Cs is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes, such information should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months. Additionally, the material provided should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business, pursuant to section 366.093(4), Florida Statutes.

WHEREFORE, for the above and foregoing reasons, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that its requests for confidential classification filed on August 31, 2007, October 18, 2007, March 24, 2008, and June 19, 2008, as amended in the manner described herein, be granted.
