REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF INFORMATION PROVIDED PURSUANT TO MID-COURSE CORRECTION DATA REQUEST NOS. 16 AND 19

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of certain information provided in connection with Mid-Course Correction data request numbers 16 and 19, that were served on FPL by Staff on June 11, 2008 ("DR. 16 and 19"). In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

- 1. On June 11, 2008, Staff served Mid-Course Correction data requests numbered 1-19, in order to gather information on FPL's Mid-Course Correction petition filing. FPL considers information in DR 16 and 19 to be proprietary confidential business information. FPL filed a notice of intent to seek confidential classification of that information on June 16, 2008, contemporaneously making the information available to Staff. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), FPL has 21 days from the date of the notice of intent to file a formal request for confidential classification. Accordingly, FPL is hereby requesting confidential classification of the information provided in DR 16 and 19.
 - 2. The following exhibits are included herewith and made a part of this request:
- a. Composite Exhibit A consists of copies of DR 16 and 19, on which all information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been highlighted. Composite Exhibit A is submitted separately in a sealed folder marked "CONFIDENTIAL."

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- b. Composite Exhibit B consists of an edited version of Exhibit A, on which all information in DR 16 and 19 that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been reducted.
- c. Exhibit C is a table containing an identification of the information highlighted in Exhibit A, together with references to the specific statutory bases for the claim of confidentiality and to the affidavit in support of the requested classification.
- d. Exhibit D is the affidavit of Gerard J. Yupp who is the Senior Director of wholesale operations in the Energy Marketing and Trading Division.
- 3. FPL seeks confidential protection for the information highlighted in Exhibit A. The highlighted information is proprietary confidential confidential business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. The information is intended to be, and has been, treated by FPL as confidential.
- 4. Pursuant the section 366.093, the information highlighted in Exhibit A is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review, such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information
- 5. As the affidavit provided in Exhibit D indicates, the information contained in FPL's responses to DR 16 and 19 include information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of FPL to contract for good and services on favorable terms to the detriment of FPL and its customers. This information is protected by section 366.093(3)(d), Florida Statutes. This information is also related to competitive interests,

and its disclosure would impair the competitive business of FPL. Such information is protected by section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes.

6. Upon a finding by the Commission that the information highlighted in Exhibit A and referenced in Exhibit C is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes, the information should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. See § 366.093(4), Florida Statutes.

WHEREFORE, FPL respectfully requests that its Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
