<u>Issue 3</u>: Are Peoples Gas System's proposed return on equity of 10.25 percent and overall cost of capital of 8.31 percent appropriate for the purpose of determining interim rates?

Recommendation: Yes. Peoples proposed return on equity of 10.25 percent and overall cost of capital of 8.31 percent are appropriate for purposes of determining interim rates.

<u>Issue 4</u>: Is Peoples Gas System's proposed April 30, 2008 interim test year net operating income of \$40,534,000 appropriate?

Recommendation: No. The appropriate interim test year net operating income for Peoples is \$41,366,000.

The interim rates should be made effective for all meter readings made on or after 30 days from the date of the vote approving any interim increase. The Company should give notice to customers of the interim increase commencing with the first bill for service that reflects the increase.
