GULF POWER COMPANY ["Gulf Power", "Gulf", or the "Company"], by and through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files a request that the Florida Public Service Commission enter an order protecting from public disclosure certain information submitted by Gulf Power in response to Commission Staff's Fifth Request for Production of Documents to Gulf Power Company (Nos.16-19). As grounds for this request, the Company states:

1. Gulf Power is submitting copies of four coal supply agreements in response to Request Number 19 of Staff's Fifth Request for Production of Documents to Gulf Power Company. One of the agreements has been executed by Gulf and the counterparty, while remaining three agreements are in the process of being finalized by the parties. Each of the agreements contains, among other things, confidential pricing information relating to coal, and each is subject to a confidentiality provision. The agreements are regarded by Gulf and the counterparties as confidential in their entirety. Disclosure of this information would negatively impact Gulf's ability to negotiate pricing favorable to its customers in the future. Potential counterparties may refuse to enter into contracts with Gulf, or may charge higher prices, if the contract terms are made public. The subject agreements constitute proprietary confidential business information regarding contractual matters which would cause irreparable harm to Gulf Power, the entities with whom it has entered contracts and most importantly to Gulf's customers if such information was disclosed to the general public. 
