At the November 13, 2008, Agenda Conference, the Commission voted to approve FPL's Application for authority to issue and sell securities during calendar year 2009, with the exception that it deferred consideration of the portion of FPL's Application related to the planned Seabrook Substation Reliability Improvement Project in the State of New Hampshire, on behalf of FPL-New England Division (FPL-NED), for construction expenditures of approximately \$30 million.
