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

CHAIRMAN CARTER: We are back on the record. And when we left, we were going to move to Item 6.

Staff, you're recognized.

MS. ROBERTS: Commissioners, I'm Lydia Roberts with Commission staff.

Item 6 is staff's post-hearing recommendation to approve a revenue increase of 22.25 percent for KW Resort Utilities Corp. Staff has oral modifications to its recommendation. These modifications affect only the interim refund issue and certain recommended rates, but they do not have any effect on staff's recommended final revenue requirement. These modifications have been provided to the Commissioners and the parties.

This is a post-hearing item for which participation is limited between Commissioners and staff. Staff is prepared to answer any questions the Commission may have.
