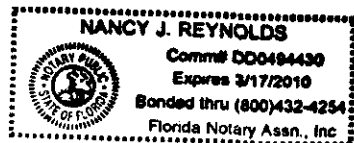

AMENDED NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF RATE INCREASE

TO CUSTOMERS OF SILVER FOX LLC d/b/a TIMBERWOOD UTILITIES

On July 14, 2008, Silver Fox Utility LLC d/b/a Timberwood Utilities (Timberwood or Utility) filed an application with the Florida Public Service Commission for a staff-assisted alternative rate setting in accordance with Rule 25-30.456, Florida Administrative Code. On December 16, 2008, the Commission voted to approve an 11.67 percent across-the-board increase of the Utility's existing rates. The Commission-approved rates are as follows:

* Due to a scrivener's error in the original Notice of Approval of Rate Increase, dated December 31, 2008, the Residential Service Gallonage Charge, per 1,000 gallons (6,000 Gallonage Cap), rate of \$6.26 is amended to be \$6.13. This Amended Notice of Approval of Rate Increase is being issued pursuant to the original Order No. PSC-09-0016-PAA-SU, issued January 5, 2009, as amended by Order No. PSC-09-0016A-PAA-SU, issued January 21 or 22, 2009.

The Commission's action approving the rate increase is preliminary in nature. Any person whose substantial interests are affected by the action proposed may file a petition for a formal proceeding, in the form provided by Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code. This petition must be made in writing and received by the Office of Commission Clerk, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, no later than by the close of business on January 26, 2009. In the absence of such a petition, the rates will be approved as final rates. If there is a timely protest, the Utility may implement the rates established on a temporary basis, held subject to refund.
