The CASR, or Case Assignment and Scheduling Record, is an internal document which staff uses to schedule certain events in a docket, such as filing a recommendation or order, or noting when an item will go before the Commission at its agenda conference. The CASR is a tentative docket schedule, subject to change over the life of a case.

To my knowledge, CASRs are not available in pdf format. However, the CASR may be accessed from our online webpage. You may view the CASR at:

The online CASR will provide the most up-to-date list of scheduled events associated with docket 080435-EI.
