**AMENDED PETITION OF FLORIDA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY  
FOR APPROVAL OF MID COURSE CORRECTION**

Florida Public Utilities Company (“FPUC”), hereby files this amended petition and requests approval by the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) of a revision to the purchased power cost recovery factor to be effective upon approval by the Commission and in support states:

1) On February 12, 2009, FPUC filed its Petition for Mid Course Correction seeking an adjustment to its purchased power cost recovery factor for the Northeast Division. As initially filed, FPUC sought approval of a recovery factor of 6.851 cents per KWH for bills from April 2009 – December 2009. The revision resulted in a bill to residential customers using 1,000 KWH of \$133.72.

2) The reason for the change is because of notification from JEA, the provider of the power purchased for the Northeast Division, of an increase in fuel costs to FPUC effective March 1. Since the initial petition, the effective date of the increase has been moved to April 1, 2009 and the result is that the revised recovery factor is 6.654 cents per KWH. With this factor, a residential customer in the Northeast Division using 1,000 KWH will pay \$131.70, and increase of \$9.31.

3) Testimony and schedules supporting this amended request are attached hereto. To the extent not inconsistent with this amendment, FPUC incorporates herein the contents of the original petition and requests the Commission to approve the revised recovery factor as modified herein.

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
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
