

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), pursuant to Sections 366.06, Florida Statutes and Rule 25-17.015 (4), Florida Administrative Code, petitions the Florida Public Service Commission ("the Commission") to approve revisions to its GSLM-2 and GSLM-3 Load Management riders, and asks for expedited treatment of this petition. As grounds therefore, the company says:

4 Tampa Electric proposes to remove the application of an Additional Customer Charge under the GSLM-2 and GSLM-3 riders. There are currently no customers taking service under either the GSLM-2 or GSLM-3 riders and there will be no revenue impact to the company or any customer from this change.

5. As a result of the company's base rate proceeding, Docket No. 080317-EI, certain customers will begin taking service under the GSLM-2 and GSLM-3 riders. In addition, customer charges for all customer classes will be reset within that docket. The new customer charges are fully cost supported in that docket; therefore, the \$200 Additional Customer Charge contained with the GSLM-2 and GSLM-3 riders is not needed to recover any incremental costs associated with service provided under those riders. As a result, the company requests that the Additional Customer Charges be removed from the GSLM-2 and GSLM-3 riders.

6. The only change in the revised tariff sheets attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is the removal of the \$200 additional customer charge. The proposed changes are shown in legislative format attached hereto as Exhibit "B".


7. Tampa Electric asks for expedited treatment of this request to ensure removal of the customer charge on May 7, 2009 to coincide with the new base rates taking effect, and when the new customers take service under GSLM-2 or GSLM-3.

8. Tampa Electric is not aware of any disputed issues of material fact relative to the subject matter of this petition.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Petition for Approval of its GSLM -2 and GSLM-3 Load Management riders as reflected in the revised tariff sheets attached hereto Exhibits "A", and "B".

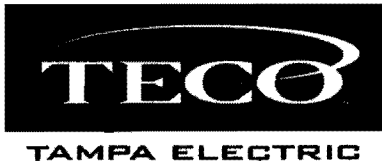

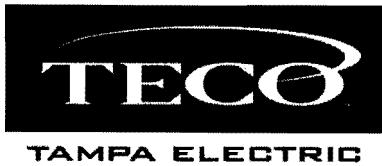
