Issue 2: Should the Commission approve Aqua's application to amend Certificates 076-W and 248-S? **Recommendation**: Yes. The resultant order should serve as Aqua's amended certificates and should be retained by the utility. The Utility should charge the customers in the territory added herein the rates and charges contained in its current tariff until authorized to change by the Commission. In addition, the Utility should be ordered to file revised tariff sheets that incorporate the additional territories within 30 days from the date of the Commission order approving the amendment.
