  - 2. In support of said request, the following information is provided.
- 3. The access line information submitted with its 2009 Local Competition Data Request contains commercially sensitive information regarding the company's operations. The disclosure of this information in the context of the above-captioned docket or otherwise could provide MetTel's competitors with valuable insight into the company's financial structure and planned operations. Because this represents highly confidential and strictly proprietary information, the disclosure of which to the public, including competitors, could result in direct and immediate harm to the competitive position of MetTel, there is a genuine need to seek non-disclosure of this information.
- 4. While the Commission needs to review this information, the general public has no direct or substantive interest in this information.
- 5. MetTel's competitors also do not require this information other than to gain potential competitive advantage or to use the information in an unfair and potentially anti-competitive manner.
