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COMMISSIONER EDGAR: That will bring us to Item 6, and we will wait just a moment to let our staff get settled.

CHAIRMAN CARTER: Madam Chair, I'm sorry about the noise in the background. My neighbor has his leaf blower out there.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: We're doing fine.

CHAIRMAN CARTER: Okay. Thank you.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Okay. I'll ask our staff to introduce the item, and I understand we have an oral modification, and ask you to present that as well.

MR. MOURING: Commissioners, I'm Curt Mouring, Commission staff. Item 6 relates to staff's recommendation for approval of a new class of service for reuse water for Indiantown Company, Inc. Staff has an oral modification for the recommendation paragraph of Issue 1 to include language for noticing and the effective date of the tariff. The Commission has already been approved -- provided this modification. Staff is prepared to answer any questions that the Commission may have.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Thank you.

Commissioner Skop.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Thank you, Madam Chairman.

Just a quick question on this item also.

I guess when we had our meeting to discuss it with staff -- I guess typically when a water and wastewater utility is creating a reuse type program, as the tariff reflects, it's often necessary not to charge for the initial quantities until you can bring some customers onboard. Is that correct?

MR. FLETCHER: That's correct.

Question I had -- and I thank staff for providing me with the reclaimed water agreement that they provided yesterday afternoon. Would that analysis change in any way if the term of that agreement is until 2025 to the extent that what incentive would Indiantown have to pursue reuse water other than having a customer that's willing to take it for such a length of time?

MR. FLETCHER: I don't believe the term of that could be addressed in their next rate proceeding.

As the years go by, the reuse service is being provided. That can be addressed in their next rate proceeding, the rate.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Wouldn't that be somewhat putting the cart ahead of the horse to the extent that that agreement would be binding? Certainly I guess it

leaves room for negotiating or giving the residual water, reuse water to Indiantown CoGen. But, again, absent -- if I had a long-term agreement, I might not be sufficiently motivated to, to really pursue vigorously

MR. FLETCHER: That agreement -- the Commission would not be bound and we could look at that in the next rate proceeding, even though that is between, that agreement is between the parties, but we can closely monitor that. And we do know that they have developer agreements, they are putting in the reuse lines and aggressively pursuing the connection of the

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. Fair enough. Madam Chair, if there are no further questions, I'd move staff's recommendation as to Issues 1 and 2.

COMMISSIONER McMURRIAN: Second.

CHAIRMAN CARTER: I would second, if there are
