On April 15, 2009, FPL provided the results of its one time refund to retail customers in March (cycle day 1 through cycle day 21), per Order No PSC-09-0024-FOF-EI, issued on January 7, 2009 in Docket No. 090001-EI. This cents per kWh credit in March produced a refund of \$5,963,904, including interest, a difference of \$733,576 from the target refund amount.

In its April billings (cycle day 1 through cycle day 21), FPL refunded an additional \$27,160, including interest, to its retail customers due to billing adjustments, resulting in a total refund amount of \$5,991,064, including interest. The total difference from the target refund amount of \$6,163,000, plus interest, is \$706,415, including interest. A summary of these results is included as Attachment I. FPL will refund this \$706,415 difference by including it in the 2009 Estimated/Actual True-Up filing in August 2009.
