By letter received March 19, 2009, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida d/b/a AT&T Southeast filed a request for approval of the one-way interconnection (paging) agreement with Priority Paging, Inc. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e). negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved. The statutory deadline for the Commission to take action on this matter was June 17, 2009.
