NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

1. Gulf Power Company ["Gulf Power", "Gulf", or "the Company"], by and through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby gives notice that it intends to request confidential classification for portions of Gulf Power's responses to Staff's Eighth Set of Interrogatories to Gulf Power Company (Nos. 40-98). Copies of the confidential documents are attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

2. A portion of Gulf Power Company's responses to interrogatory numbers 46, 48, and 49 contain proprietary confidential business information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of Gulf Power and its affiliates. The information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to section 366.093(d)(c), Florida Statutes. Specifically, the confidential information consists of Gulf Power's projections of annual price streams for carbon dioxide allowances. Public disclosure of this information could give fuel and equipment vendors, as well as potential competitors, a competitive advantage over the Company and its customers. Additionally, all of the subject cost estimates have been produced with the assistance of an economic consulting firm using proprietary models and confidential data, both the use by and application of the models to the Company are subject to a confidentiality agreement.

3. A formal request for confidential classification will be filed within the time period specified in Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, if the Staff determines that the information will be retained by the Commission and not returned to Gulf Power Company within

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the specified time period. In the event the Staff determines that it will retain this information, Gulf Power Company requests to be notified, through the undersigned counsel, prior to the expiration of the period specified in Rule 25-22.006(3)(a).
