By letter received May 20, 2009, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida d/b/a AT&T Southeast filed a petition for approval of an amendment to the interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement with Tele Circuit Network Corporation. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved. The statutory deadline for the Commission to take action on this matter was August 18, 2009.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on August 4, 2009. The agreement met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.5.d of the Administrative Procedures Manual.
