Item 5 addresses the six telecommunications service quality rules remaining for consideration from Docket No. 080641, initiation of rulemaking to amend and appeal rules in Chapter 25-4 and 25-9.

The Commission proposed these rules for adoption in the January 23, 2009 Florida Administrative Weekly and gave interested persons the opportunity to submit written comments or to request a hearing.

The ILECs, which we've referred to as joint petitioners in the past, and the Communication Workers of America filed written comments

concerning the five service quality rules which are 1 addressed in Issue 1. 2 As has been mentioned, the preferred carrier 3 fees rule, which is addressed in Issue 2, has been deferred to the September 15, 2009 agenda conference. Participation of this item is limited to Commissioners and staff. Staff is available to 8 answer any questions. 9 CHAIRMAN CARTER: Thank you, staff. 10 Commissioners, we are now on Issue 5, and staff has 11 reiterated that -- on Item 5, staff has reiterated 12 that Issue 2 of Item 5 has been deferred until the 13 September 15, 2009 agenda conference. 14 And with that, let's proceed on the issue as 15 presented. Any questions? Any comments? 16 Okay. No questions, no comments.
