RE: Recommendation to Office of the General Counsel - Docket No. 090458-TL – Petition for expedited review of growth code denials by Number Pooling Administrator for the Main switch within the Ft. Pierce exchange by AT&T.

On August 6, 2009, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida d/b/a AT&T Southeast, (AT&T) filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar) for the Ft. Pierce exchange, Main (FTPRFLMADS0) switch. AT&T requested one (1) number block of 1,000 numbers to meet the request of a specific customer for 600 new consecutive numbers, in the specific format of NPA NXX-2XXX or 6XXX. On August 6, 2009, AT&T's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust and utilization criteria.

On September 24, 2009, AT&T filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order No. PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the AT&T petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) The customer will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (October 13, 2009), as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide AT&T the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Ft. Pierce exchange, Main (FTPRFLMADS0) switch.
