JOINT PETITION TO AMEND TERRITORIAL AGREEMENT

Progress Energy Florida, Inc. ("PEF") and Reedy Creek Improvement District ("RCID"), jointly petition the Florida Public Service Commission to amend the current territorial agreement between PEF and RCID that was approved by the Commission per Order No. PSC-94-0580-FOF-EU on May 17, 1994 for the purposes of boundary modification in one area to resolve outstanding issues and hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

- PEF is an electric utility organized under the laws of Florida and is subject to the regulatory jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Section 366.04(2), F.S.
 PEF's principal offices are located in St. Petersburg, Florida.
- 2. RCID is a special district organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida and is authorized to furnish electricity and power to areas of Orange and Osceola counties in Florida.
- 3. All pleadings, notices and other communications in this matter should be served on the undersigned representatives for the Parties.
- 4. PEF and RCID are parties to a currently effective territorial agreement delineating their respective territories which was approved by the Florida Public

- 5. The Northeast Resort Parcel/Golden Oak Estates PD which is currently located within the service territory of RCID will soon be developed. This area, as shown on Exhibit A-1, was de-annexed from the RCID political boundary in June 2008. Further, RCID, in accordance with its charter, cannot furnish retail electric power outside of the RCID boundary. RCID has provided a letter requesting PEF provide temporary service to the Northeast Resort Parcel/Golden Oak Estates PD area until such time as RCID and PEF can effect a permanent change in service territory.
- 6. In accordance with Section 2.2 of the Agreement, the Parties request that PEF provide electric service to the customer's end-use facilities in the Northeast Resort Parcel/Golden Oak Estates PD and that the territorial boundary be modified to reflect this change and placing the area within the PEF service territory as is reflected in Exhibit A-2.

WHEREFORE, the Parties respectfully request that the Commission grant this Petition to approve the above-described permanent power service.
