REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF INFORMATION PROVIDED IN RESPONSE TO STAFF'S FIRST SET OF OF INTERROGATORIES NO. 1

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of certain information provided by FPL in response to the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission's ("Staff's") First Set of Interrogatories No. 1, which was served on January 14, 2009 (the "Confidential Response"). Staff's First Set of Interrogatories was served in Docket No. 090001, but review of replacement fuel costs associated with the February 26, 2008 outage was subsequently spun off to Docket No. 090505-EI by Order No. PSC-09-0723-PHO-EI, dated October 30, 2009. In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

1. FPL served its responses to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories on Thursday, November 19, 2009 for hand delivery to Staff. FPL considers information responsive to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories No. 1 to be proprietary confidential business information. Accordingly, FPL filed a Notice of Intent to Seek Confidential Classification on November 19, 2009. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, FPL is filing this Request for Confidential Classification.

2. The following exhibits are included with and made part of this request:

a. Exhibit A consists of a copy of the confidential material on which all information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been highlighted.

b. Exhibit B consists of a page identifying the title of the confidential document and noting that the contents are confidential. Because FPL seeks confidential

c. Exhibit C is a table containing an identification of the information highlighted in Exhibit A, together with references to the specific statutory bases for the claim of confidentiality and to the affidavit in support of the requested classification.

d. Exhibit D consists of the affidavit of Pedro Modia, Director of Transmission Services and Planning, in support of this request.

3. FPL submits that the highlighted information in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes. This information is intended to be and is treated by FPL as private, and to the best of FPL's knowledge it has not been publicly disclosed. Pursuant to Section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.

4. As the affidavit included in Exhibit D indicates, the information provided by FPL contains security measures, systems, or procedures protected by Section 366.093(3)(c), F.S. Specifically the report contains information details about the Flagami Event, FPL's system restoration, and design and equipment performance. Additionally the response provides details of the Flagami Event human investigation.

5. Upon a finding by the Commission that the information highlighted in Exhibit A, and referenced in Exhibits B, C, and D is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), the information should not be declassified for a period of at

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least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer

necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. See § 366.093(4).

WHEREFORE, FPL respectfully requests confidential classification of the Confidential

Discovery Responses as described herein.
