Mr. Rock, the Governor's office sent this Commission a copy of your letter concerning your application to the FCC to discontinue long distance service. If your company wishes to cancel its IXC registration in Florida you need to request cancellation with this Commission by writing to the Commission Clerk and paying any regulatory assessment fees due. Florida Administrative Code 25-24.474(2) outlines the requirements for IXC cancellations:

(2) If a registered company desires to cancel its registration, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request:

- (a) Current and any past due Regulatory Assessment Fees, and the associated penalty and interest; and
- (b) A statement on treatment of customer deposits and final bills.
- (3) Cancellation of the IXC registration shall be granted subject to the holder providing the information required by subsection (2).

I have attached your company's Regulatory Assessment Fee form for 2009. The minimum payment for 2009 is \$700. Your company also owes a past due amount of \$35.55. This can be included in the same check. Please be sure to include the RAF form and payment of \$735.55 with your cancellation request. If your request is not received before 2010 your company may be subject to 2010 RAF.



APPLICATION

Pioneer Telecom, Inc., pursuant to the procedures set forth in Section 63.71 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, hereby respectfully submits this Application to discontinue the provision of long distance telephone service. At this time, it is no longer feasible for Pioneer Telecom to provide resold long distance service to its customer base of approximately 500 small businesses and residential customers. Pioneer Telecom is a non-dominant provider of long distance services.

The information required by Section 63.71cb) is set forth below. Pioneer Telecom, Inc. understands that its application will be automatically granted on the 31st date following the release date of the Public Notice of Pioneer Telecom's discontinuance application without further action from the Commission unless the Commission advises Pioneer Telecom, Inc. to the contrary.

I. Pursuant to Section 63.71 (b)(1) through (5) (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(b) (1) through (5), Pioneer Telecom Inc. submits the following information:

A. Name and address of carrier.

B. Date of planned service discontinuance

The anticipated date for the discontinuance of Pioneer Telecom's service is October 31, 2009 or as soon thereafter as the necessary governmental approval can be obtained.

C. Points of geographic areas of service affected:

The proposed discontinuance will affect the provision of Pioneer Telecom long distance service in the states of California, Florida, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York, and Texas.

D. Brief description of the type of service affected

Pioneer Telecom currently provides long distance service including interstate and intrastate outbound, inbound (toll free) and calling card service.

E. Method of Notice to Customers

Each of Pioneer Telecom's customers will receive a telephone receive a notification letter, inserted in a Pioneer Telecom bill, mailed on September 25, 2009. A copy of the notice letter is attached. Parenthetically, we can also add that virtually all of our customers have also been contacted by telephone.

F. Non-dominance of the carrier with respect to the service being discontinued.

Pioneer Telecom, Inc. is a non-dominant carrier providing long distance telephone service.

G. Service

In accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules, Pioneer Telecom, Inc. has mailed a copy of this application to the Governors of the affected states, to all affected state public utility commissions and to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications for the Secretary of Defense.


II. Circumstances of Discontinuance
