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PROCEEDINGS

CHAIRMAN CARTER: I would like to call this agenda to order and kind of get us all in a posture for our hearing. We're now called to order. And, Commissioners, before we get to the move staff list, or the agenda, I'm going to take the opportunity to pass the gavel to Commissioner Edgar so I can be recognized for a motion.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Thank you.

Chairman Carter, you're recognized.

CHAIRMAN CARTER: Thank you. Thank you, Madam Chair and to my fellow Commissioners.

It is my honor and privilege to nominate Commissioner Nancy Argenziano as Chair of the Florida Public Service Commission for the years 2010 through 2012.

The basis of my nomination is because throughout her adult life she has answered the call to leadership. Before her appointment to the Florida Public Service Commission in May of 2007, Commissioner Argenziano served more than ten years in the Florida Legislature. She answered the call to leadership. She was first selected to the Florida House of Representatives in 1996. That's District 43, and she served there until her election

to the Florida Senate in 2002, District 3. She answered the call to leadership.

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While serving in the Legislature, she served on many different committees and councils, including Chair of Governmental Oversight, Chair of Criminal Justice, Chair of Agriculture, Chair of Elderly Affairs, Chair of the Health Care Council, and member of numerous other committees and councils, including water resource management, utilities and communications, and the Public Service Commission Oversight Committee. She answered the call to leadership.

Commissioner Argenziano's legislative career focused on protection of the elderly and on other vulnerable citizens, resource protection, and the full participation of all citizens in their government. She answered the call to leadership.

Notable legislation which she sponsored, I won't name all of them, but some of them were like nursing home reform, local sources first in terms of water use, a law providing for clearing the courtroom for victim sex crime testimony, enhanced penalties for crimes against the elderly, Public Counsel representation in utility rate cases, protection of our springs, and scam busters, a

program for the protection of consumers, and protection of our children from sexual predators, the Jessica Lunsford Act. That is just to name a few of the things that she did in the Senate and the Legislature. She answered the call to leadership.

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Commissioner Argenziano has one son,

Joseph, who just as his mother had done, proudly
served his country for 14 years in the United States

Air Force. She answered the call to leadership.

Now that our Commission needs to rise to new heights
to meet new challenges and to boldly go where no PSC

Commission has gone before, I take this honor and
privilege to nominate my friend, my fellow
colleague, and my fellow Floridian as the next

Chairman of the Florida Public Service Commissioner.

And, Commissioners, I ask for your unanimous
support. Thank you.

commissioner edgar: Mr. Chairman, thank you for your words of leadership and statesmanship, and I give you back the gavel to please preside.

CHAIRMAN CARTER: Thank you.

Commissioner Edgar, you're recognized for the motion.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Thank you, Mr.

Chairman. And I am pleased to have the opportunity

to second the motion of our Chairman Matthew Carter, and I second his motion to nominate Commissioner

Nancy Argenziano to be our next chair. I am pleased to have the opportunity to work with you during these next few years.

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And if I may take the opportunity for a little more personal take on it. As some of you may remember, I had the opportunity to serve as chair early in my tenure here at the Commission, and I found it incredibly rewarding and at times incredibly frustrating. I know that you -- I know that you will have some of those same feelings. It is one of those jobs that until you are kind of right in it, it's hard to know exactly what all is expected and required. But I offer you my full support.

As we all know we serve as independent Commissioners and each of us, our vote is individual to us and is what we carry and what only we can answer to. But I do believe that by the selection of your colleagues, that as Chairman, you deserve our support, and you deserve some deference, and I offer you both of those from me. And I hope to work with you and to help you in any way that I possibly can. And I look forward to your leadership and to

the opportunity to continue to learn from you.

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COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Thank you.

COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Mr. Chairman.

CHAIRMAN CARTER: Thank you. Commissioner Skop, you're recognized.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Thank you, Mr. Chair.

I will keep this short. I don't really know what to say other than, Commissioner Argenziano, your consumers love you, your constituents back home love you, and I'm honored and privileged to serve with you on this Commission. So congratulations.

CHAIRMAN CARTER: Thank you. Commissioner Klement, you're recognized.

COMMISSIONER KLEMENT: Thank you, Mr.

Chairman. I would like to add my congratulations to the incoming Chair and wish her all the best. I will be watching closely to learn all that I can from you, and as I have the outgoing Chairman. From my perspective as a relative newcomer, it appears to be a very demanding role and an often thankless one, and I will promise to do all I can to make your term as Chair as smooth and effective as possible. But I would also like to commend Chairman Carter for his

work as Chairman, and to say that I have been -(Applause.)

impressed with your mastery of the speakers role, the gavel, presiding over often contentious hearings with a calm and cool demeanor. That's very impressive. Not to mention your impressive oratorical skills, which I envy. And, Mr. Chairman, you have given us a good example of a steady experienced hand at the helm, and I thank you for your service, and as we transition in the new year to the new Chairman.

CHAIRMAN CARTER: Thank you.

Commissioners, there's a motion and a second on the floor. All in favor of the motion, let it be known by the sign of aye.

(Simultaneous aye.)

CHAIRMAN CARTER: All those opposed, like sign. We now recognize our Chair Designate,

Commissioner Nancy Argenziano.

COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Thank you very much.

I really appreciate the kind words and the support. And, Chairman Carter, I really appreciate your chairmanship. As Lisa Edgar -- Commissioner

Edgar, excuse me, when I first came in, it is a tough job and you guys did a great job, and I will always be looking to all of -- we are independent Commissioners. This is an administrative position and I will never forget that, though it is not an easy one. Juggling schedules of five Commissioners as well as the agendas of the utilities we regulate and the consumers out there is not easy. And I know it isn't. And all I can tell you is I pledge to you that I will do what is required of me as Chairman. I am going to need your help, and I don't expect -- what I do expect is that each one of you remember you are independent Commissioners. And if there is something that you need from the Chair, please let me know.

I respect the fact that we are independent and want to keep it that way. I think it is extremely important. And anyone who comes after us needs to know that that is what this Commission is about. We can have difference of opinions, and whatever it is I want to accommodate my colleagues in the chairmanship role, and I will need your help in doing that. And I am honored by your support today. And to everyone out there, to our staff at the PSC, while we have a hard and rough and tumbling

times, I do very much appreciate what you all do here, and we can't do this job without you.

And to the utilities who are going (noise) please realize that I am fair and will always be fair, and as an independent Commissioner I am just one here. So don't fear and don't fret. And to the consumers out there, we are trying our best to make you feel confident, and I know all my colleagues feel that there's been a lot of headlines, and we are all working to try to make this the best PSC we can have.

So with that said, I do appreciate it, and do pledge to you that I understand we are independent and each one of us has an extremely important role. So with that said and new beginnings coming and the new year ahead of us, let's just go to work and hopefully we can do it in a collegial way and still understand we can have differences of opinion.

And as Chair, I understand that that is not the big kahuna. It is just one who accommodates scheduling, and I want you to know I'm not on any high horse. And if anybody thinks that is so, that is not the case. And if I am, I expect each one of you to knock me down a peg. So with that, thank you

COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: And, Mr. Chair, I didn't thank you, really, both of you, as the incoming PSC Commissioners, to have you both as chair meant a lot, and we will call you on. Even though you may not be here, I will call on you.

CHAIRMAN CARTER: Okay. For the record, for the record, for staff, and for the court reporter, it was a unanimous vote. The vote was unanimous for the record.
