On June 11, 2009, Docket No. 090331-TP was established to address the cancellation of Preferred Carrier Services, Inc. d/b/a Telefonos Para Todos and d/b/a Phones For All's competitive local exchange telecommunications service (CLEC) Certificate No. 4682 and intrastate interexchange telecommunications (IXC) Registration No. TI458 due to bankruptcy of the company.

By Order No. PSC-09-0528-PAA-TP, the Commission granted cancellation of the company's CLEC Certificate No. 4682 and IXC Registration No. TI458, effective June 11, 2009. The Commission further ordered that the Division of Administrative Services shall be notified that the unpaid Regulatory Assessment Fees shall not be sent to the Department of Financial Services for collection, instead permission for the Commission to write-off the uncollectible amount will be requested.

Therefore, staff requests that the Division of Administrative Services takes the appropriate steps to seek permission from the Department of Financial Services to write-off the uncollectible amounts.

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any judicial review of Commission orders that is available pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water and/or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Office of Commission Clerk and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
