- 3. In reference to the Residential Solar Water Heating (Low Income New Construction) Pilot Program, please explain why retrofitting existing systems was not included as an option.
- 4. In reference to the Business Photovoltaic's for Schools Pilot Program, please explain what size PV system will be installed or how the size of the PV system to be installed will be determined.
- 5. In reference to the Renewable Research and Demonstration Project (Page 37 of the Plan Document), please explain how FPL's proposed Research and Development Projects will not duplicate the efforts of the Florida Solar Energy Center.
