The purpose of this letter is to inform the Florida Public Service Commission and the parties to the above-referenced proceeding that FPL has withdrawn its St. Lucie Unit 1 Extended Power Uprate ("EPU") License Amendment Request ("LAR") that was filed with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC"), and is preparing to re-file the LAR to address requests for information made by the NRC staff. The NRC has acknowledged FPL's request to withdraw the LAR. FPL met with the NRC on August 18, 2010 to discuss the additional technical information requested for the St. Lucie Unit 1 LAR. FPL intends to revise the LAR to include the additional information in order to enable the NRC staff to accept the LAR and complete its detailed review. FPL expects to resubmit the revised LAR as soon as practicable. Please call me if you have any questions.
