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

**JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND
DEADLINE FOR FILING PROJECTION TESTIMONY**

Gulf Power Company, Tampa Electric Company, Progress Energy Florida and Florida Power & Light (the "Companies") pursuant to Rule 28-106.204, Florida Administrative Code, hereby request that the Commission grant an extension of time to file projection testimony in the above-referenced docket. In support thereof, the Companies state as follows:

1. The current deadline for filing projection testimony in this docket is September 10, 2010.

2. On Friday, September 3, 2010, the Companies received a request from Commission Staff that the Companies include two alternative scenarios for recovery of DSM-related costs in their projection filing/testimony for this docket. Scenario (1) would project costs assuming the utilities continue to implement the programs that exist in their current, approved DSM Plans. Scenario (2) would project costs assuming that the utilities implement programs contained in their DSM Plans which are currently before the Commission for approval.


3. Given that projection testimony is due on September 10, the Companies are in need of additional time to address Staff's request. The Companies request leave to file their projection testimony on or before September 17, 2010.

4. In the interest of administrative efficiency, Gulf Power has been authorized by Tampa Electric Company, Progress Energy Florida and Florida Power & Light to request this extension on their behalf.

5. Gulf Power has conferred with the parties in this docket and has received confirmation from the Florida Industrial Power Users Group, the Office of Public Counsel, PCS Phosphate and Florida Public Utilities Company that they have no objection to the requested extensions.

WHEREFORE, Gulf Power, Tampa Electric Company, Progress Energy Florida and Florida Power & Light request that the Commission grant the Companies leave to make their projection filings on or before September 17, 2010.
