Enclosed for filing, on behalf of Staff, is the original and seven copies of the revised page 7 of the Direct Testimony of Debra M. Dobiac.

On September 3, 2010, staff filed the testimony and exhibits of staff witness Debra M. Dobiac. In Audit Finding 5, page 7, line 9, the following language should be added at the beginning of the last sentence: "Except for the reclassification of Insurance – other expense to Miscellaneous Non-utility expense in the amount of \$12,020,". Further, in preparing its Prehearing Statement, staff discovered that it had accidentally pulled the wrong number (\$10,313) for reducing O&M Expenses for activities outside the test year or for insufficient supporting documentation. The correct number should have been \$9,588. Accordingly, line 13 of page 7 has been revised to reflect the correct number of \$9,588. Therefore, the attached Revised page 7 should replace the original page 7 of Ms. Dobiac's testimony filed on September 3, 2010. By this memorandum, staff is copying all parties with a copy of the revised page 7.

Please substitute the corrected page 7 for the originally filed version. Thank you for your assistance. Staff regrets any inconvenience this oversight may have caused.

11	have no effect on total O&M Expenses.
12	Audit Finding 6
13	This finding relates to expenses recorded in the test year that were for activities
14	outside the test year or had insufficient supporting documentation. O&M Expenses should
15	be reduced by \$10,313 \$9,588.
